*In question 3A-4 the question asks for the percentage of individuals and persons in families returning to homelessness over a 6- and 12-month period as reported in HDX. The calculation is adding the 6 month number to the 6-12 month number and dividing by the universe of persons exiting to PH. Note that this calculation is different than last year so the comparison is affected.
