The full DuPage County CoC Snapshot will return in the spring of 2021.






## 2019 DuPage County CoC Snapshot





# Persons Served by Project Type:





The DuPage County CoC has worked towards implementing adjustments to the way individuals experiencing homelessness access permanent housing (permanent supportive housing and rapid rehousing) with the goal of expediting housing placements as quickly as possible, ensuring our system remains flexible as we work to house those experiencing homelessness in light of COVID-19. The DuPage County CoC has developed a COVID-19 Rehousing Response, following guidance provided by local public health officials, as well as state and federal partners.
