RE: NOTIFICATION OF 2021 PROJECTS ACCEPTED AND RANKING

The DuPage Homeless Continuum completed the project selection and tiering process on October 6, 2021. Sixteen projects were recommended for inclusion on the 2021 Project Priority Listing. This included 4 new projects and 12 renewal projects.

The 4 new projects accepted for inclusion on the 2021 Project Priorities Listing included:

The DuPage CoC Rank and Review committee scored each new and renewal application from the Business Plans and Cost Forms submitted which incorporate the 2021 Ranking Criteria. The Ranking Criteria contains objective measure of project outcomes including system performance measures, project performance, administrative ability and utilization. All projects submitted were placed in order of scoring on the CoC Project List. Committee objectives were to maximize the scores of projects in Tier Two to increase the likelihood of getting funded. One renewal project, New Beginnings RRH, was selected to straddle the position between Tier One and Tier Two in order to place 1 new project in Tier One. This Rapid Rehousing project was chosen over PSH in order to avoid displacement of any persons in permanent housing units. The 360 Youth Services Expansion project is a priority because it provides both new transitional housing and new rapid rehousing units for youth which has been determined to be a high priority need. In Tier Two, the straddle renewal project was followed by the DuPage PADS Expansion of New Beginnings RRH. The amount was reduced to fit Tier Two required total.

The DV bonus project, Haven of Hope Rapid Rehousing, was placed last in Tier Two so it would not affect funding of higher priority projects and is not part of the Tier Two amount.

The Planning project is included in Projects Accepted but is not ranked according to HUD guidelines.

HUD will select all project amounts in Tier One from the highest scoring CoC to the lowest scoring CoC before selecting any project amounts in Tier Two. Tier Two projects will be scored individually by HUD up to 100 points each. In Tier Two, HUD will select projects in order of point value from all CoCs. The DV bonus will be scored on a different 100-point scale that is evaluated nationally.
