RE: NOTIFICATION OF 2021 PROJECTS REJECTED AND REDUCED

The DuPage Homeless Continuum completed the project selection and tiering process on October 6, 2021. The DuPage Homeless Continuum evaluated closely the actual funds expended and outcomes of all renewal projects to determine performance and make decisions regarding project reductions. There were no project reductions to existing renewals.

There was 1 voluntary project reallocation. DuPage County Community Services eliminated the Resolution Housing RRH project after determining that the CoC had higher priority projects in the new projects being applied for and that the ESG-CV, ERAP and Treasury funds could better serve clients applying for this program.

Projects Reduced

One new project was reduced for inclusion in the 2021 competition. The DuPage PADS New Beginnings RRH Expansion project amount had to be reduced to fit in the Tier Two amount using part of the CoC bonus.

Projects Rejected

There were 2 projects rejected. One project was eliminated due to reallocation. For the 2021 CoC application, DuPage County Community Services indicated their intention to voluntarily reallocate the Resolution RRH total project amount of \$196,112. The DuPage PADS Hope Place PSH Expansion was rejected due to lack of any remaining funds in Tier Two. The PSH expansion was the lowest scoring application of the new projects. The PSH beds were a lower priority because the DuPage Housing Authority is allocating Mainstream vouchers and Emergency Housing Vouchers to expand PSH beds.
