We received **official** word, in WellSky's email below, that the FY24 updates to the APR/CAPER reports will not be available until **December 2023**.

As noted in our email yesterday (attached), HUD is requesting that those with reports due now through December need to request an extension through the local HUD Field Office rep. For ESG CV reports, requests must be submitted through the CARES representative. Please do not submit an AAQ through HUD.

Unfortunately, we do not have any additional information regarding these delays at this time. We ask that you share this information with others at your organization as appropriate.

WellSky important update

WellSky would like to provide you with information about the next upgrade to Community Services. Community Services 5.15.01 will be available as a **Minor** Release in the upgrader the week of October 23, 2023. This means that only sites that are not set up for automated upgrades will require scheduling.

This release version will include the following changes:

- Coordinated Entry Event
 - Resolved issue where Provider Lookup logic was not filtering or populating Providers correctly
- Client Merge
 - Resolved issue where "Error performing Assessment Visibility comparison" prevented merging client records
- Race and Ethnicity Mapping
 - Resolved issue where selecting both non-HUD and HUD values resulted in a Null value after upgrading to CS5.15.0.

Additional timeline information for HUD Reporting is available below:

LSA

HUD announced on October 18, 2023, that the LSA submission window is expected to begin on November 13, 2023, and end on January 17, 2024. CoCs are expected to upload a draft submission by November 29, 2023. WellSky will announce the availability of the FY2023 LSA export on or before November 13, 2023, in a future announcement. There will be no required upgrade for the export's availability.

CoC APR/ESG CAPER

WellSky plans to release the FY2024 CoC APR and the FY2024 ESG CAPER reports on December 8, 2023, as part of 5.15.02. WellSky advises grantees to reach out to their CARES Act Desk Officer for ESG-CV, or their CPD representative in the field office for APR/YHDP, to request submission extensions for grants due between now and mid-December. Each grantee must reach out directly, as HUD will not be able to grant a blanket

extension.


Coordinated Entry APR, DQF and PATH

FY2024 versions of these reports are expected to be released mid to late December 2023. Grantees with Coordinated Entry APR deadlines between now and late December 2023 are advised to reach out to their CPD representative in the field office to request a submission extension. Each grantee must reach out directly, as HUD will not be able to grant a blanket extension. The PATH annual report deadline is December 31, 2023. Data Quality Framework data will be used in the FY2023 SPM submission in February 2024.

SPMs

The SPM series of reports will be updated to the FY2024 specifications in January 2024. More information about release timing will be available near the end of the calendar year.

WellSky important update

WellSky is sharing a communication from the HUD SNAPS office related to delayed APR/CAPER/CE APR/ESG-CV/YHDP reporting:

"This message serves as an update to a previous listserv from September 27th where HUD acknowledged communities were experiencing delays in submitting required reports because of challenges with HMIS Data Standards updates. In that message, HUD asked recipients to contact their Community Planning and Development (CPD) Representative for further guidance. We understand many of you have done this and are awaiting updated guidance.

HUD understands that, while HMIS vendors have been working diligently to address issues impacting reports, some systems are not able to generate required reports as of today. If the HMIS vendor delay is preventing a recipient from submitting a timely report, then HUD plans to treat it as an unforeseen circumstances beyond the Recipient's control and consider it a mitigating factor when monitoring for program compliance. Reports must be submitted to HUD as soon as practicable, which we currently estimate will be December 15. Please also maintain a record of the notification from the Recipient's HMIS vendor of delays in reporting implementation.

You do not need to contact your CPD representative at this time."
